CORRECTION YOU KNOW?



In the last issue of the Tars and Tripe it was incorrectly stated that Seaplanes do not require the red and green navigation thats boats do. One of our members who is also a Seaplane pilot informed me that is not the case. See the info below and Thank You to Howard Riley for the information.

Please note the following FAA rules - these apply to all aircraft including seaplanes!

- (c) Visual flight rules (night). For VFR flight at night, the following instruments and equipment are required:
 - (1) Instruments and equipment specified in paragraph (b) of this section.
 - (2) Approved position lights.

This means that ANY aircraft flying at night must have the same "position" lights as all of our boats!

Additionally, for general information, when seaplanes are on the water they are required to conform to all requirements of sea craft.




