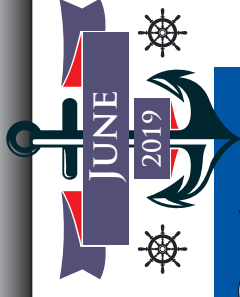

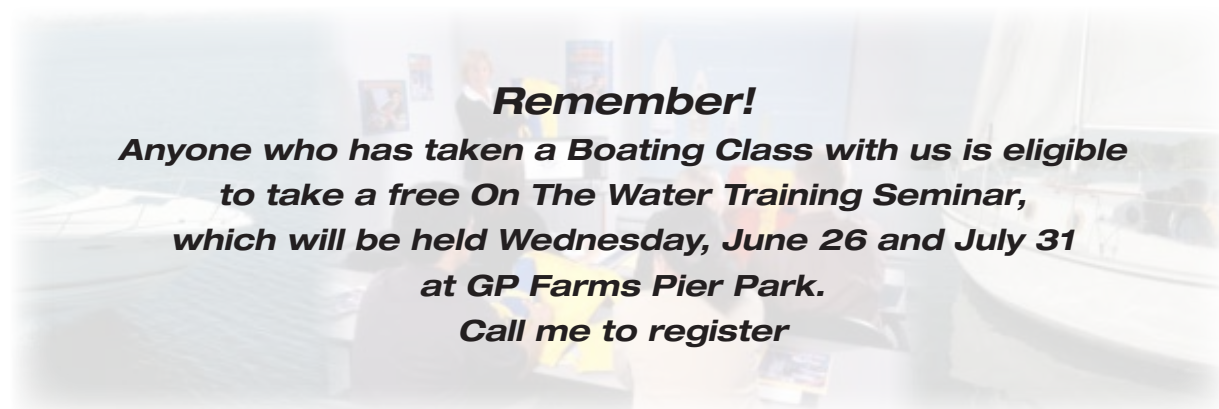
## SEO Report Lt/C Chet Dunbar Jr., AP

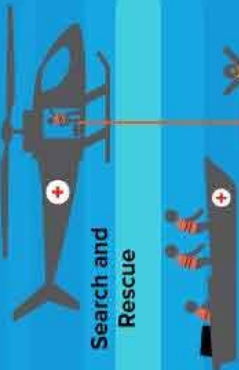

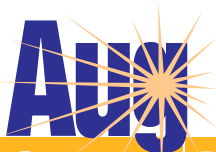
