Spring has sprung and for us mariners April 1st is the start of the season when boat insurance coverage starts and the average low temperature rises above freezing. Of course that's average and this is still Michigan, and the nights could go below freezing. Ice flows were coming down the St. Clair River but Lake St. Clair looks open. Walleye fishing will be starting on the Detroit River. As the temperatures rise and the winds subside activity will start picking up. This is a tremendous fishery.

If you do launch early make sure that your boat is trim and shipshape, that you have all required equipment aboard and you dress warmly. It may be 60 degrees on land but it will feel a good 10 degrees lower on the water, especially with water temperatures hovering around 40 to 45 degrees. Also there will be fewer people out there so help may be delayed. At America's Boating Club your safety is of utmost importance. Get a Vessel Safety Check before you go. Call P/D/C Bill Stano at 313 343 5602 to set up a time.

On the boat show scene, the Annual Novi Spring Boating Expo came to the Suburban Collection Showplace in Novi, MI. Attendance was strong. District 9 had the Virtual Trainer set up and operating. This was a big hit with the show goers, especially with the kids. Testing your boating skills knowing that mishaps were virtual was comforting. Maybe too comforting since some adults had a tendency to deliberately crash the boat into breakwalls and bridge abutment to see what would happen. A big thanks goes out to Duane Carlson and Greg Gampert from Mt Clemens PS, Tom Smith and Bob Blau from Birmingham PS, and Frank Muylaert from Dearborn PS for setting up the equipment and assisting with its operation.

On the USPS National scene, we are still losing about 1400 members per year and we are down 10 squadrons. The Squadron Development and Leadership Committee, which began in 2000, has helped more than 30 new squadrons to receive their charter through the Provisional Squadron approach. They have also helped many squadrons to return to active viable status. These accomplishments have helped retain members as well as add new ones.

The work on re-branding USPS to America's Boating Club continues. National has been rolling out TV and print ads explaining our mission. We must be warm and welcoming to all outdoor groups offering courses and programs to appeal to all. Live the logo and put time in what is working, not in that which is not working. It was also suggested that squadrons which incorporate America's Boating Club in their name are seeing an increase in membership. Something to think about.
