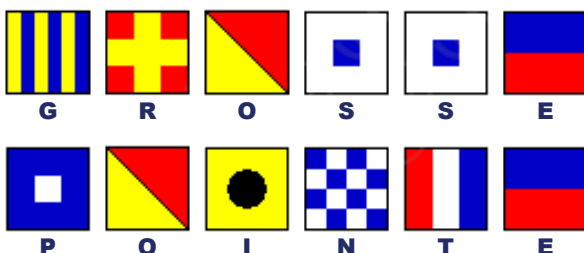

## Fire Extinguisher Update

The Coast Guard amended fire extinguishing equipment regulations to comply with the National Fire Protection Association's recommendations. This new fire extinguisher regulation became effective on **20 Apr 2022**.

If a disposable (non-rechargeable) fire extinguisher is older than 12 years, the extinguisher is considered expired and cannot be counted toward a boat's required number of extinguishers. The boater can find the manufacture date on the bottom of the bottle or near the URL label. It may appear as two or four digits (e.g., 08 or 2008). Rechargeable and fixed-mount fire extinguisher regulations have not changed; they require regular servicing by a technician. The number of fire extinguishers required on a boat has not changed.

In addition to the information discussed above:

For 2018 model boats or newer:

- The boat must carry "5-B", "10-B", and "20-B" classified extinguishers. The number on the new labels refers to the size (in square feet) of a potential fire the device is suitable to extinguish.
- For boats 26-65 feet the requirements vary.

For 2017 model boats or older:

- May carry older "B-I" or "B-II" disposable extinguishers until their 12-year expiration date, and then they must be replaced with newer class extinguishers.
- Boats built prior to 1952 have special rules.

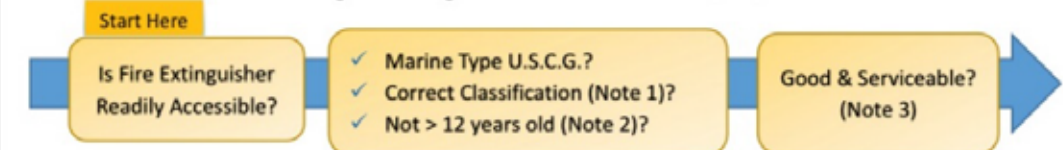

### Fire Protection for Recreational Boats

New regulation goes into effect on 04/20/2022



- Note 1 – a.** Extinguishers **UL Classified 5-B:C/10-B:C** (or greater) meet carriage requirements for ALL recreational vessels regardless of vessel age.  
**b.** Extinguishers rated as **Marine Type USCG Type B:C, size I or size II** are only acceptable on vessels built model year 2017 or earlier.  
*(Model year means the period beginning June 1 of a year and ending on July 31 of the following year and being designated by the year in which it ends.)*  
**c.** Ratings that include higher numbers or more letters are acceptable.  
**d.** One 20-B extinguisher may be carried to replace two required 5-B extinguishers.  
**e.** There are special rules for vessels built prior to 1952.

**Note 2 –** Make sure disposable fire extinguisher is not more than 12 years old from date stamp on bottle. Must be removed from service on 31 December of the 12<sup>th</sup> year.

**Note 3 –** See Good & Serviceable meaning below.

**Good and serviceable** working condition means:

- (i) If the extinguisher has a pressure gauge reading or indicator it must be in the operable range or position;
- (ii) The lock pin is firmly in place;
- (iii) The discharge nozzle is clean and free of obstruction; and
- (iv) The extinguisher does not show visible signs of significant corrosion or damage.

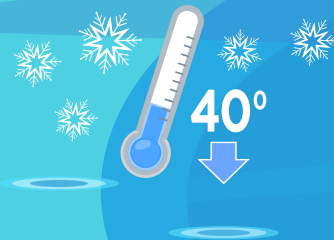

## Attention!

Per your Port Captain, Michael Pipia,

**Yes, you can now go to Canada for Boating and Travel.**



Starting April 1, 2022 Boaters who plan to make land fall or travelers go over bridge/ tunnel need to download mobile app or go on-line to create an account in ArriveCAN. This is a new health declaration form to prevent spread of COVID-19. It is mandatory to complete information including full vaccination status ( 2 shots) before entering and indicate time of arrival and any symptoms. After registering, the traveler will be issued a reference number and bar code which they present on arrival.

If you are only sightseeing on boat or pleasure fishing, you are not required to create account as long as you do not touch Canadian Soil by anchoring, mooring, or come along side another vessel in Canadian waters. In order to fish in Canadian waters, you need a valid Ontario fishing license and you MI state ID/ NEXUM card or Passport. 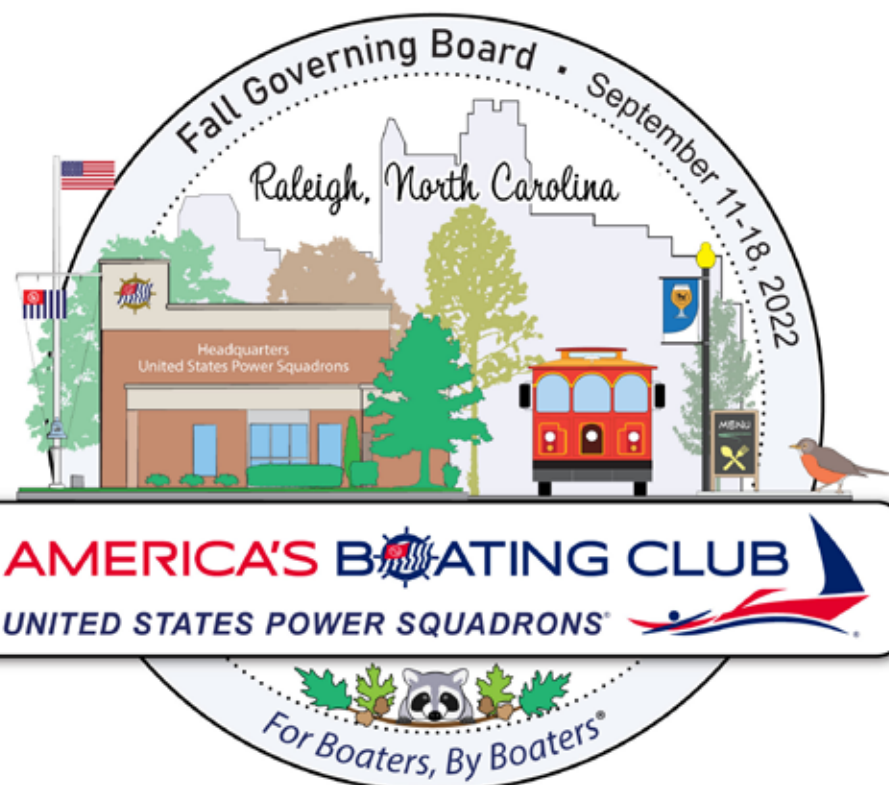
