

Random Thoughts From the 2023 Annual Meeting in Orlando, Florida.

DB2000 is old technology no longer being supported by our national organization. That means USPS is no longer updating DB2000. You can no longer upload things like name changes or address changes and you can no longer submit merit marks through DB2000. Information from DB2000 is stored on your personal computer however our national organization is no longer providing updates through DB2000 and will not accept updated information through DB2000. All member updates are now done through the Information Center. The Information Center page on the National Web site has several videos and power point presentations on how to use and update member information. At the Annual Meeting in February, I attended a seminar on the Information Center.

Two important questions were asked which affect all of use using the Information Center. "Will I be able to send emails with attachments through the Information Center?" The answer to this question was a one-word answer, "NO!" The expectation is to send an email with a link to the attachment you normally send in an email. The other questioned asked was "Can I print address labels from the Information Center?" Once again, the answer was a short "No!" There are no plans to set up the ability to print labels from the Information Center. The expectation is for the user to download an excel file (or CSV file) and use mail merge in MS Word to create your mailing labels. For some people, using mail merge can be frustrating to use.

How savvy is your squadron or club with social media? Does your club or squadron use social media to advertise your educational offerings or events? What are the benefits of your club/squadron from using social media (from the Simplilearn website):

USPS has a social media committee who developed a 26- page social media Playbook and social media policy. The Social Media Playbook and Policy are located in the National Website. Click on Resources tab at the top of the USPS site and then click on the Guidebook Links.

Vessel Safety Check Information

- 1. There is a new downloadable Vessel Safety Check brochure that you can customize for your club.
- 2. There is a new USCGAux 2023 Vessel Examiner Workshop which must be completed by 30 June 2023. Please visit the Vessel Safety Check webpage to complete the workshop.
- 3. There is a changed vessel safety request email system. When someone requests a VSE, an email will come to the examiner but not link to the requester.


